## The Venue

Located geographically at the precise center of India, Nagpur is known as “Zero Mile Centre” of India. Nagpur is also known as “Orange City” because it is a major trade center, cultivator, and exporter of high-quality mandarin oranges relished for its sweet and tangy taste, as well as also known as “Tiger Capital of India” as it provides gateway to six major Tigre Reserves of India. Blessed with the thick tropical dry deciduous and mixed deciduous forests, the Nagpur and adjoining areas like Melghat (Amravati), Gadchiroli, Gondia, Bhandara districts possess the treasure of medicinal plants in abundance. The Waigaon Turmeric is a geographically tagged (GI) premium spice from Wardha district, which is just an hour drive from Nagpur is renowned for its medicinal value due to exceptionally high curcumin content (over 6%), deep mustard-yellow color, and intense, pungent aroma. Apart from the Zero Mile marker of India and jungle safari, the Nagpur and surrounding areas have popular tourist attractions like Gorewada Zoo, Dikshabhumi, Ramtek Temple, Swaminarayan Temple, Sevagram etc.

## The Nagpur Veterinary College and MAFSU

Nagpur Veterinary College (NVC) was established on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 1958 and it is a constituent college of Maharashtra Animal & Fishery Sciences University (MAFSU), Nagpur. As one of the oldest veterinary colleges of Central India, the NVC is well known for its quality teaching, research and extension programs. Established on 3<sup>rd</sup> December, 2000, the Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University (MAFSU) is considered as the biggest Veterinary and Fishery sciences university in India in terms of the number of constituent colleges. Presently, the university has eleven constituent colleges comprising six Veterinary, three Fishery and two Dairy Technology colleges. Additionally, the Wildlife Research & Training Centre at Gorewada was established in the year 2015 to cater the needs of wildlife health management and research. The university has five Cattle Breeding Farms across the state with the mandate to conserve local germplasm and also 3 KVK's at Nagpur, Sangli and Thane.

## Scientific Program

The conference, to be held over two days, will comprise the keynote address and theme papers, technical sessions and presentations covering relevant current aspects of Ethno Veterinary and Herbal Research. It is intended that all the challenges and problems relevant to the proposed theme will be brought to the table and solutions will be developed through the exchange of experiences and scientific knowledge. There will be six technical sessions including oral and poster presentations in each session. The thematic areas are:

- Preclinical validation of medicinal plants for pharmacological properties
- *In silico* herbal drug development
- Advances in phytochemical screening of medicinal plants
- Alleviation of Antimicrobial & Antiparasitic resistance with medicinal plants
- Clinical validation of medicinal plants for the disease of livestock, pet animals and poultry
- Advancement in the use of herbs as nutraceuticals

## Call for Abstracts

The organizing committee of the ETHNOVETCON-2026 invites all the potential research and field individuals for the conference and invites scientific abstracts for presentation or poster of their original research work not exceeding 500 words. The abstract shall be typed in Times New Roman font with the font size of 12 and spacing of 1.5 lines. It shall clearly mention the title, author(s) details, institute/organization details, presenting authors email and keywords at the end of the abstract.

## Poster Presentation

The posters for all the scientific areas shall be printed in the size of 3 ft width and 4 ft height. Please do not mention the details of authors and institute on the poster, as a code number will be allotted to each poster for fair evaluation

## Awards

The three Best Oral Presentation Awards and three Best Poster Awards will be presented separately for Faculties/Researchers/Field Veterinarians and Students for each scientific theme.
